

**Coordinating Commission Report  
Presbytery of Transylvania  
December 3, 2024**

Since the August presbytery meeting, the Coordinating Commission of the Presbytery of Transylvania met on September 25, 2024, October 30, 2024, and November 19, 2024.

Commission Actions:

- Reviewed summary budgets of presbytery, Burnamwood, and Urban Village through October 31, 2024.
- Called a presbytery meeting for October 7, 2024, to address leadership issues at the Hopewell Church, Paris.
- Encouraged commissions and ministries to discern ministry goals for 2025.
- Work to provide “thank-you” items for those ending terms on presbytery commissions.
- Awarded a technology grant to Urban Village in the amount of \$1788. (This grant depletes the technology grant funds that were awarded to the presbytery by the Synod of Living Waters.)

Recommended Actions:

- The Coordinating Commission recommends that the presbytery revise the Manual of Operations. (See document to follow. Additions are underlined; deletions are ~~strikethrough~~.)
- The Coordinating Commission recommends that the presbytery approve a proposal supporting the legacy fund of Living Waters for the World. (See document to follow.)
- The Coordinating Commission recommends that ruling elder Jim Magee (Troy Presbyterian, Versailles) be elected to Commission on Representation, class of 2027.
- The Coordinating Commission recommends that the presbytery approve the following meeting dates for 2025: Saturday, March 1; Tuesday, May 20; Saturday, August 16, at First Presbyterian Church, Somerset, KY; and Tuesday, December 2.
