ABOUT PER CAPITA

PER CAPITA IS A COVENANT COMMITMENT FOR ALL COMMUNICANT MEMBERS OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH THROUGH THE GOVERNING BODIES TO PARTICIPATE EQUALLY, RESPONSIBLY, AND INDEPENDENTLY BY SHARING THE COST OF COORDINATION AND EVALUATION OF MISSION.



For 2023, per capita amounts remain unchanged for Presbytery -- \$25.51 per member -- and Synod -- \$3.98 per member levels from 2022. A slight increase from 2022 -- \$0.63 per member -- for 2023 is being assessed for the General Assembly portion.

THE PAYMENT OF THE PER CAPITA APPORTIONMENT CAN BE SEEN AS A SIGN OF HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS WITHIN THE CHURCH, GIVING TANGIBLE WITNESS TO THE UNITY AND WHOLENESS PROMISED TO US IN JESUS CHRIST.
