- High School Diploma/GED

TASKS

The Burnamwood Summer Camp Counselor will:

- Supervise campers (ages 9-18) in small groups, cabins, and camp recreation and report (per Presbytery of Transylvania Personnel Guidelines) any violation of camp policies, procedures or rules that may affect the safety, health or well being of any camper or staff member.
- Personally adhere to all policies, procedures, rules or covenants of Burnamwood and Presbytery.
- Serve as leaders and mentors to all campers and build positive relationships
- Promote a safe and engaging Christian camp experience
- Assist with the cleanliness of facilities and grounds of Burnamwood in order to ensure safe and clean environment.
- Facilitate summer programming (hikes, worships, games, meals, small groups, and other activities similar in nature)
- Able to reach all parts of Burnamwood.
